warm sun in the summer could result in some oil tanks cracking and even splitting. Please ensure there are no cracks or marks on your oil tank. Even the smallest mark on your tank could result in your tank splitting which could lead to many more problems.

Extra Vigilance needed regarding Stolen Oil


Local Garda have informed us there is a rise in Oil being stolen from tanks.
